- Effective with the Class of 2010: A proposed two-course Connection must link courses from at least two different Areas, a three-course Connection must link courses from three areas: History, Creative Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Math/CS.
- The faculty teaching each course in the Connection must approve the proposed Connection.
- One course cannot be used in two Connections.
