

## CONNECTING TO THE NETWORK

Wheaton College employs a Network Access Control system (NAC) called Campus Manager. Campus Manager secures the network by isolating and authenticating users before they can connect to the production network. It also verifies that computers meet minimum hardware and software requirements.

### Connecting to the Network

1. Setup, plug-in, and turn on your computer
2. Launch your web browser.
3. You will be presented with a page which contains the College Networks Acceptable Usage Policy (AUP).
4. Click on the link at the bottom to acknowledge and accept the AUP.
5. You'll now be presented with the main Registration page. Select the Students link to register your computer. (Students can't use Guest Access).
6. After selecting the Students link to register your computer, you'll see a page with information about the Client Security Agent (CSA) which will test your computer, detailed registration instructions, and entry boxes for your Wheaton ID, password, and computer type.
7. Fill in the entry boxes and click Download/Verify. Save the CSA to your desktop. Once it is saved, run the CSA.

8. If your computer passes inspection it will be registered on the network and you'll be allowed full network access.

### If You Failed Inspection

If your computer does not pass inspection you will be presented with a page detailing the reason(s) it didn't pass and links to information on how to fix the problem(s). Common causes of failure are out-of-date antivirus software or an Operating System that doesn't have the latest patches. When in doubt, run System/Automatic Updates and antivirus updates until there are no more to download. Then re-run the CSA.

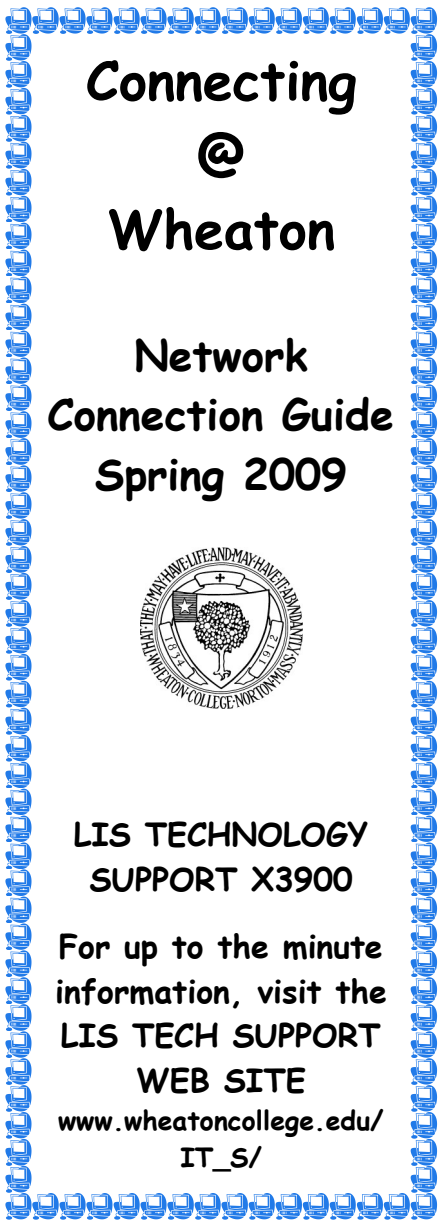
