How Do I Find News Articles On Cognitive Psychology Topics?

EurekAlert! – Science News -- the online news service operated by the American Assn. for the Advancement of Science for distributing scientific news to the media and to the public via the web. Releases on *EurekAlert!* are posted from research institutions, corporations, government and nonprofit organizations. Look up or browse for information by clicking on the topic, *Social & Behavior*, subtopic, *Memory/Cognitive Processes* under *News by Subject*. You can also type specific information into the *Search* or *Advanced Search* window for releases 1996- .

InfoTrac Expanded Academic, 1980-current

Indexes articles from a large variety of magazines, news sources, and journals in the humanities, social sciences and sciences. Many full-text articles are included.

How Do I Find Journal Articles Reporting Experimental Research In Cognitive Psychology?

InfoTrac Expanded Academic
[as above] Indexes articles from several journals in psychology and related disciplines.

PsycINFO, 1887-current (in two files: 1872-1973 and 1974-present)
Indexes the professional and academic literature in psychology and related disciplines; includes citations with abstracts (summaries) and -- for American Psychological Association publications -- full-text (*PsycArticles*). Comprehensive indexing for psychology.
