## WHEATON HOLDS ON TO DEFEAT MT. HOLYOKE, 57-51 IN WOMEN'S HOOPS

February 19, 2000

The Wheaton College women's basketball team finished its regular season with a narrow 57-51 victory over Mount Holyoke College at Emerson Gymnasium in the regular season New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) finale on Saturday afternoon.



Wheaton started play with an early 7-2 lead, but Mt. Holyoke fought back to tie the game at 10-10 with 13:07 to go. There were four ties in the first half, along with two lead changes and nine jump balls. Lyon senior April Dingwell (Brockton, MA/Brockton H.S.) was forced to sit out with 15:35 remaining on the clock due to foul trouble. In came junior Bonnie Campbell (Stoneham, MA/Stoneham H.S.), who grabbed eight of her game-high tying 11 boards in the opening half to go along with her game totals of eight points and five blocks. Wheaton went into the half with a 25-24 advantage.

The second half, like the first twenty minutes of play, followed suit with high intensity, as the two teams fought through four lead changes and three ties. Wheaton was held without a field goal for a 10:37 span midway through the half, but was able to rely on its free throw shooting, where they shot .875 (21-24 FT) from the line in the latter half to win the game. With just over eight minutes to play, the Lyons trailed 43-41, but Dingwell would go on to score eight straight points to give her team a permanent lead at 49-46 with 2:26 remaining. Despite her fouling out of the game, Dingwell led the team with 14 points, making a perfect eight for eight from the charity stripe in the second half. She also grabbed eight boards on the afternoon.

Freshman Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.) rounded out the Lyons' double-digit scoring with 10 points. Teammate Stacy Auerr (Holliston, MA/ Holliston H.S.) added nine points and nine rebounds in the Wheaton victory.

Mt. Holyoke's freshman Jessica Justice (Doylestown, PA) scored 13 of her game-high 20 points in the second half, which accounted for nearly half of Mt. Holyoke's second-half scoring. Justice completed her double-double with 11 rebounds in the losing effort. Freshman Laura Dodge (Coeur D' Alene, IA) added 11 points for the Lyons.

Wheaton finished its season with a 14-9 overall record and 5-4 mark in the NEWMAC, including a No. 5 seed for this year's conference tournament. The Lyons are set to face No. 4 Clark University in Worcester, MA on Wednesday, February 23 in the first round, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Mt. Holyoke, 12-12 overall and 4-5 in the conference, dropped to the sixth seed and will play at No. 3 Springfield College on Wednesday night, also a 7:00 p.m. start.

## WHEATON SQUEAKS BY MIT IN NEWMAC GAME, 59-56

February 15, 2000

The Wheaton College women's basketball team defeated the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) Engineers, 59-56 in a New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) contest on Tuesday night. The victory advances the Lyons to a 13-9 record, including 4-4 in the NEWMAC. The Engineers fall to 5-16 and 2-6.



In the first half, Wheaton and MIT battled back and forth through six ties and six lead changes until 3:50 remained on the clock. A Jennifer Schefiliti (Shelton, CT/Shelton H.S.) three-pointer began an 11-4 run to give the Lyons a 29-24 lead at the break. Megan Daugherty (Manchester, CT/Manchester H.S.) led the Engineers with seven points at the half.

Wheaton led by as many as 15 points in the second half, however MIT fought back to tie the game at 49-49 with 4:50 remaining in the game. The Engineers trailed 46-32 with 9:26 on the clock, but went on an 11-0 run over the next three minutes to cut the Lyons' lead to three points. Wheaton forward April Dingwell (Brockton, MA/Brockton H.S.) added six of her game-high 24 points in the last 4:10 to keep her team in the contest. Engineer Amy Mok (Waltham, MA/Newton North H.S.) scored five points late to bring her team within one point at 57-56 with 10.6 seconds to go. Mok led her team with 14 points. MIT was forced to foul allowing Wheaton two Kerri Deshefy (Clinton, CT/The Morgan School) free throws from the charity stripe to win the game. Deshefy finished with nine points and three boards on the night.

Freshman Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.) added 10 points and five rebounds in the Lyons win. Largess, who leads the conference in assists with 5.39 apg, was right on pace with five tonight. Dingwell's 24 points and 10 rebounds was her second straight game with a double-double and her fourth in the last 10 games.

MIT's Christina Estrada (Bogota, Colombia/Santa Francisca H.S.) also achieved a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds, respectively. Daugherty finished with 12 points and 4 rebounds.

Wheaton's final game of the regular season is Saturday, February 19 at 2:00 p.m. The Lyons will host Mount Holyoke College (12-10, 4-4 NEWMAC) in a conference contest.

## WHEATON TOPS WPI IN NEWMAC CONFERENCE GAME; 70-54

February 5, 2000

The Wheaton College women's basketball team led from the tip-off until the final buzzer forty minutes later, as the Lyons downed Worcester Polytechnic Institute (WPI), 70-54 in a New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) contest. The victory improves Wheaton to 11-7 overall and 3-2 in the NEWMAC.



In the first half, the Lyons were not able to pull away from the Engineers until 4:07 remained on the clock. Wheaton held a 28-20 advantage and then went on a 10-0 run to gain a 38-20 lead going into the break. Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.) paced the Lyons early with all ten of her points coming in the opening half. Largess, who leads the NEWMAC in assists, recorded nine in today's contest. WPI's Helen Gwizdak (Plaistow, NH/Central Catholic H.S.) kept her team in the game with 10 of her game-total 16 points coming in the first half.

The second half was controlled by Lyons' junior Bonnie Campbell (Stoneham, MA/Stoneham H.S.), who led the team with a season-high 16 points, shooting a perfect eight for eight from the field. Campbell also rounded up six rebounds and two blocks. Wheaton pulled away from the Engineers on another 10-0 run late in the second half.

The Lyons were again able to rely on senior forwards April Dingwell (Brockton, MA/Brockton H.S.) and Stacy Auerr (Holliston, MA/Holliston H.S.). Dingwell ended the afternoon with ten points and a team-high eight rebounds, while Auerr added 14 points and three boards. Wheaton also found scoring in guard Kerry Deshefy (Clinton, CT/The Morgan School), who had eight points in the Lyons' win.

For the Engineers, sophomore Rachel Zimet (Trumansburg, NY/Dickerson H.S.) led all scorers with 20 points, as well as a game-high 12 rebounds. Teammate Becky Dowd (Dunstable, MA/Groton-Dunstable) added a 10-point showing in the loss.

The Wheaton Lyons will play at Wellesley College in its sixth conference game of the season on Tuesday, February 8th at 7:00 p.m.

## **WHEATON DROPS CONFERENCE GAME TO BABSON, 56-52; LYONS FALL TO 9-7 OVERALL AND 2-2 IN THE NEWMAC**

February 1, 2000

The Wheaton College women's basketball team led for the first 38 minutes of play but ended up losing its New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) game, 56-52 to Babson College on Tuesday night in Emerson Gymnasium. 

Wheaton led the entire first half from its opening three-point shot until its final free throws. The Lyons' April Dingwell (Brockton, MA/Brockton H.S.) controlled the boards by pulling down nine of her game-high 15 rebounds in the opening half. The team's biggest lead of the half at 22-12 came off of a Jennifer Schefiliti (Shelton, CT/Shelton H.S.) three-point bucket with 9:52 remaining. Wheaton then began to struggle in the scoring category, as the Lyons managed only one field goal the rest of the way. However, Wheaton kept its lead at the break, 32-29.

The second half began to follow suit as the two teams exchanged baskets. Wheaton maintained a 49-45 advantage with 5:19 to play, but Babson went on an 11-4 run to finish the contest. The Beavers took their first lead of the game at 54-52 off an Ingrid Miller (East Lyme, CT/East Lyme) right-handed lay-in with 1:34 on the clock. With a Lyons' turnover, the Beavers regained possession of the ball and the game. Wheaton was forced to foul and give up two more points in free throws.

Senior captain Stacy Auerr (Holliston, MA/Holliston H.S.) led Wheaton with 12 points. Freshman Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.) added eight points and a game-best four assists in the loss.

For the Beavers, Miller led the way with a game-high 18 points. Miller entered the contest with a season average of 7.8 points per game. She also grabbed a team-high eight rebounds. Angela Botticelli (Wakefield, MA/Wakefield H.S.) contributed 10 points and three rebounds for Babson.

With the loss, the Lyons fell to 9-7 overall and 2-2 in the NEWMAC. The Beavers improve to 11-8 and a perfect 4-0 in the conference. Wheaton will suit up again this Thursday, February 3 at Emmanuel College, starting time 7:00 p.m.

### **DINGWELL LEADS LYON WOMEN IN OVERTIME; TEAM TURNS BACK SMITH COLLEGE IN CONFERENCE OPENER, 67-62**

January 22, 2000

Senior April Dingwell (Brockton, MA/Brockton H.S.) provided a crucial lay-up late in the second half to push the game into overtime and seal the win for the Wheaton College women's basketball team on Saturday afternoon. The Lyons overcame a large second-half deficit to upend Smith College, 67-62 in their New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) opener.



In the first half, the Lyons never led but stayed within reach, trailing 10-7. Smith then reeled off nine straight points and extended their lead to 19-7 midway through the half. The Lyons would cut the Pioneers' spread to four at 28-24 with 6:00 remaining. But the Smith senior duo consisting of guard Antonia Bowman (Healdsburg, CA) and forward Lauren Kernochan (Santa Monica, CA) proved to be too strong as each contributed to the Pioneer attack with 13 and 12 points, respectively. Kernochan also added 10 boards for a first half double-double. The Pioneers shot a proficient 53.1% (17-32 FG) in the half, as they retained a 40-28 lead at the intermission.

Smith held a game-high 14 point lead early in the latter half, but Wheaton quickly responded, rushing out to a 17-3 run led by two Kerry Deshefy (Clinton, CT/The Morgan School) jump shots and a three-point bucket to even the score at 47 points apiece with 13:54 on the clock. The Lyons wasted no time, as they took advantage of Smith's Kernochan early departure from the game (18:07) with four fouls. She did not return until Wheaton held its first advantage of the contest, leading 55-53 on a Dingwell freebie. The game remained close for the final seven minutes, as the Lyons trapping defense forced 11 Smith second half turnovers while shutting down the Pioneers, holding them to a mere six points in the final ten minutes of play.

Wheaton had a chance to win the game in regulation, as freshman guard Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.) shot but misfired on a buzzer-beating jump shot from the top of the key. Overtime belonged to the Lyons, outscoring Smith 8-3 in the session, on the rebounding and blocking power of Dingwell and the four clutch free throws from Deshefy.

Dingwell led the Lyons in scoring for the third straight game, tallying a team-high 16 points. Deshefy was not far behind with 15 points, while three other Wheaton players scored eight points. Largess paced the Lyons with a game-best seven assists.

Bowman paced the Pioneers with a game-high 17 markers and team-high six assists. Kernochan contributed to the defeat, scoring 15 points while grabbing a game-best 17 rebounds. Junior guard Beth Rist (Easthampton, MA) and junior forward Rachel DeFina (Burnaby, BC, Canada) added 13 and 10 points, respectively.

The Lyons have now won four out of their last five games en route to a 8-5 overall mark and 1-0 record in the NEWMAC. Smith fell to 4-10 and 0-2 on the season. Wheaton will continue its conference play on Tuesday, January 25 at Coast Guard Academy, starting time 7:00 p.m.

### WHEATON WOMEN FALL TO COLBY COLLEGE, 68-47; WHITE MULES WIN WITH BIG SECOND HALF

January 15, 2000

The Wheaton College women's basketball team was defeated in its non-conference game to Colby College, 68-47 on Saturday afternoon in Emerson Gymnasium. This marked the Lyons' second loss in as many years to the White Mules. Colby, currently the third-ranked team in the New England Region, participates in the New England Small College Athletic Conference (NESCAC).



Wheaton trailed through the entire first half managing only two ties midway through the opening twenty minutes of play. The Lyons fell behind early, as they were down 8-1 with just under fourteen minutes left in the half. Wheaton responded with seven straight points on an April Dingwell (Brockton, MA/Brockton H.S.) foul shot to even the count at eight points apiece. Colby used strong offensive rebounding while taking advantage of the Lyons' 13 first half turnovers to extend its lead to 25-19 with 4:02 remaining. The White Mules entered halftime with a 31-28 advantage.

Colby's freshman center Sarah Walsh (Catonsville, MD/Seaton Keough H.S.) opened up the next half on a terror, as she contributed eight of the team's first 10 points and 15 total second half points, pushing the White Mules' lead to 50-34 with 8:55 on the clock. Wheaton would get no closer, as the Lyons were outscored in the second half alone, 37-19. Colby out rebounded Wheaton by a count of 49-35 and ended the contest with 14 steals in comparison to the Lyons' four.

Dingwell was the only Lyon in double-figure scoring, posting 12 points on 4-4 FG, pulling down a team-best nine rebounds and blocking three shots. Freshman guard Jennifer Schefiliti (Shelton, CT/Shelton H.S.) added eight points while junior center Bonnie Campbell (Stoneham, MA/Stoneham H.S.) recorded season-high's of seven points and five rebounds in 20 minutes played.

Walsh led the way for Colby with a double-double in points and rebounds, posting game-high's of 19 points, 14 rebounds and six steals. Walsh, who entered today's game averaging 11.9 points per game, poured in 19 for the second straight game, as she did against Bates College last Thursday. Junior forward Mandy Cochrane (Arlington, MA/Arlington H.S.) added eight points, while four other White Mule players had seven in the win.

## LYONS WOMEN'S BASKETBALL DROPS TO 4-4 ON THE SEASON; TUFTS UNIVERSITY WINS IN COMMANDING FASHION, 70-45

The Wheaton College women's basketball team dropped its non-conference game to Tufts University 70-45 on Saturday afternoon in Emerson Gymnasium. Wheaton's record, now 4-4, falls to an even .500 for the first time all season as the Jumbos, a member of the New England Small College Athletic Conference (NESCAC), remain undefeated with a 5-0 mark.

After six lead changes and six ties in the opening half, Tufts went on an eight to two run in the closing minutes, as the Jumbos took a 33-28 advantage into the intermission. Tufts freshman center Emily Goodman (Briarcliff, NY) made her presence felt on the court early in the first half with five points and five rebounds.

The Jumbos opened the second half with another eight to two run, increasing their lead to 41-30 with a little over 15 minutes to play. Lyons freshman Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.) bounced back and hit two three pointers to break Tufts' momentum with 14:18 remaining in the half. The Jumbos would then take the game into their own hands, as they reeled off 14 straight points, while holding Wheaton scoreless over the next seven minutes and twenty seconds. This offensive stretch for Tufts proved to be the back breaker for the Lyons, as the Jumbos extended their lead to 55-36 and never looked back.

Largess led Wheaton in scoring with 11 points on 3-6 shooting from behind the arc, accompanied by her game-best five assists. Senior April Dingwell (Brockton, MA/Brockton H.S.) contributed with a season-high 10 points (5-7 FG), while grabbing a team-high tying six rebounds and adding four assists in the Lyons defeat.

Goodman led the charge for Tufts, as she recorded a game-high 18 points (7-13 FG) in 26 minutes. Senior captain Molly Baker (Northfield, MA) finished the contest with 14 points and a game-high seven rebounds, while freshman Erin Harrington (Fall River, MA) rounded out the Jumbos double-figure scoring with 10 points (3-3 FG, 3-4 FT) in 16 minutes.

The Wheaton women will be off until Thursday, January 6 when they visit Gallaudet University in Washington D.C. Tip-off is set for 7:00 p.m.

The Wheaton College women's basketball team dropped its game to Salem State by a final count of 69-53 on Thursday night, as the Lyons fall to 4-3 on the season. After stringing together three straight wins, Wheaton has lost three of its last four contests. With the victory, the Lady Vikings improved their overall mark to 3-3.



Wheaton's only lead of the game was on the opening bucket off a lay-up by senior captain Stacy Auerr (Holliston, MA/Holliston H.S.) for the 2-0 advantage. The Lyons would keep close range as they trailed the Vikings 22-15 with a little over five minutes to play before Salem State pulled away with a 10-2 run over the next two minutes to increase its lead to 32-17. The Lyons struggled for most of the first half with 11 turnovers compared to the Vikings' three giveaways. But Wheaton would fight back as they scored eight straight points to narrow the lead to 32-25. The Lyons trailed at the intermission 34-25.

Auerr paced the Lyons in scoring as she finished with 13 points and nine rebounds in the contest. Teammates Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.) completed her night with eight points and a game-best eight assists, while Jessica Arment (Lee, MA/ Lee H.S.) added 10 points (5-6 FG).

The Salem State Lady Vikings were led by junior guard Melissa Smock (Belmont, MA/Belmont H.S.) with a game-high 19 points, which included 6-11 from behind the three-point arc. She was aided by freshman Kara Smolinsky (Ashburnham, MA/ Oakmont), who added 15 points and five assists in the win. Senior guard Adrienne Johnson (Dorchester, MA/Cathedral) recorded 12 points and pulled down eight boards, while freshman Betsy Nichols (Gardner, MA/Gardner H.S.) was one rebound shy of a double-double with 10 points and nine rebounds.

The Lyons will play the Tufts University Jumbos this Saturday, December 11 in Wheaton's Emerson Gymnasium, beginning time at 2:00 p.m. Tufts, who plays in the New England Small College Athletic Conference (NESCAC), will enter the contest with a 4-0 record.

## **LYON WOMEN TOPPLE SIMMONS COLLEGE, 62-28; REMAIN UNBEATEN AT 3-0**

For the second straight meeting in as many years, the Wheaton College women's basketball team defeated the Simmons College Sharks, as the Lyons raised their overall and home mark to 3-0 with a decisive 62-28 win against the Boston team. The 38-point margin of victory was the largest for a Wheaton team since the 1995-96 campaign when the women defeated Umass-Dartmouth by a final of 100-62 on February 13, 1996.



In what started out to be a close encounter between the two squads quickly turned one-sided in favor of the home team, as the two team's combined for a mere 20 points (10-10) midway through the first half. Following a Lyons timeout sophomore forward Dustan Peet (Hampden, ME/Hampden Academy) provided a much needed spark, as she reeled off three consecutive buckets to give Wheaton a 16-12 advantage with 6:52 to play. Peet proceeded to steal the ball from a Simmons defender and then dished out an assist to freshman Jessica Arment (Lee, MA/Lee H.S.) for the easy left-handed lay in.

From the time the Lyons called their timeout at the 10:40 minute mark of the opening half, the Wheaton women managed to put up just 4 points shy of the Sharks' 28-point final output off a 24-6 run that gave them a commanding 34-16 lead at the intermission.

The second stanza was much a continuation of the first half as the Lyons full-court pressure proved to be too much for Simmons. Wheaton scored the first nine points in the second frame for a 41-16 lead, including a three-pointer from Cornell transfer Kerry Deshefy (Clinton, CT/The Morgan School), and held the Sharks scoreless for nearly eight minutes stemming back to the 2:38 minute mark of the first half. Things would become progressively worse for the visitor's as they fell behind by as many as 36 points at 60-24 with 2:40 remaining on the clock.

The Lyons had twelve of their fourteen player's compound the scoring totals, as two managed double-figures in scoring. Peet led the attack with a game-high 12 points (6-8 FG) in 15 minutes, while co-captain Stacy Auerr (Holliston, MA/Holliston H.S.) rounded out the women's squad with 10 points (5-10 FG) in 17 minutes played. Freshman Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.) contributed to the Wheaton victory with a career-high 9 assists, while sophomore reserve Siobhan Kelley (Berlin, NH/Berlin H.S.), who saw her first action of the season, cleaned the boards with a team-high seven rebounds.

Simmons College junior Kristen Roberts (Center Conway, NH) was the Sharks' top scorer with eight points in the losing effort. Forward Amy Heath (Toledo, OH) led all rebounders in the game with 10.

The Wheaton women will begin preparations for Brandeis University, as they will face the Judges for their first road game of the season on Tuesday, November 30. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. in this non-conference contest.

## WHEATON BREAKS THREE YEAR STREAK IN TIP-OFF CLASSIC; UPENDS CASTLETON STATE COLLEGE (VT), 58-51

The Wheaton College women's basketball team defeated Castleton State College (VT) with a 58-51 win in the championship game of the Wheaton College Tip-Off Classic today in Emerson Gymnasium. This victory breaks the Lyons three-year drought and moves them to a 2-0 record for the first time since the 1995-96 season.



Wheaton led throughout the majority of the contest, with the exception of being down 30-29 early in the second half when Spartans' forward Merritt Walker (Plymouth, MI) buried two free throws. Castleton State did not let down as Jen Heath (Williamstown, VT) hit a three-point baseline shot at the 2:55 minute mark to close the gap to 50-47. The Spartans were able to cut the game down to 52-51 off of two free throws from Sarah Barth (Windsor, VT), but the Lyons withstood the Spartan attack as they came back with two quick foul shots from Kerry Deshefy (Clinton, CT/The Morgan School). With Wheaton ahead 54-51 at the 30-second mark and Castleton State with possession, senior Stacy Auerr (Holliston, MA/Holliston HS) managed to steal the ball in the low post area to insure the Lyon victory.

Co-captain Lisa Pensinger (Bridgewater, MA./ West Bridgewater HS) helped her team jump out to an early lead by scoring the first nine of 11 points for the early 11-8 Lyon advantage. Freshman Erin Largess (Shrewsbury, MA/Shrewsbury H.S.), who was named most valuable player for the two-day tournament, continued to show her ability to create offense with 14 points, including 3-6 from the 3-point arc, and six assists. Wheaton's Auerr also was selected to the all-tournament team.

Castleton State junior Janna Walker (Island Falls, ME), who was named to the all-tournament team, led her squad with 18 points and five rebounds. Senior guard Heath recorded seven of her 15 points for the Spartans late in the second half, but they weren't able to change the momentum of the game.

In the consolation game, Eastern College (PA) carried a 19-0 run in the first half to secure the win over S.U.N.Y.-New Paltz (NY), 60-45. Twin sisters Andrea and Christine Collesidis (Moorestown, NJ), who accounted for 46 percent of their teams scoring last season, scored 40 of the team's 60 points. Andrea led all scorers with 22 points and added 10 rebounds, while Christine scored 18 points with 12 boards. Their opponent, S.U.N.Y.-New Paltz, was led by Robin Sheilds (Staten Island, NY) with 19 points. The Hawks would not recover as they couldn't overcome the first-half 18-point deficit.

Wheaton's next game will be played on Tuesday, November 23, as the Lyons remain at home to face the Simmons College Sharks, beginning at 7:00 p.m.
