

## ECONOMICS

Minimum courses required: 11

Prospective majors should consult with the department chair early in their academic career. To major in Economics, students must maintain a grade-point average of **C or higher**.

The department recommends that students complete ECON 101 and ECON 102 or 112 (in either order) and MATH 102 first.

Students considering graduate study also should complete extensive course work in mathematic.

Please note that ECON 150, Principles of Financial Accounting, does not count toward the major.
