

## HISPANIC STUDIES

(Requirements for students who entered Wheaton before fall 2006)

Minimum courses required: **9**

Students interested in the Hispanic Studies major should discuss their plans with department as early as possible. An individualized program of study, based upon the personal preferences and career aspirations of the student, will be designed.

Some requirements can be filled through study abroad in Spain, Wheaton's interdisciplinary Programa de Estudios en la Universidad de Cordoba (PRESHCO) and the Program for Mexican Culture and Society in Puebla, Mexico (PMSCP). The department recommends that students pursue a second major or a minor.

Please note that HISP 101 and HISP 102, Basic Spanish, are **not** open to students who have taken Spanish previously.
