

ART HISTORY MINOR

Minimum courses required: 5

The minor is designed to provide a cohesive chronological survey of art history, augmented by an in-depth study of three area in which the student has a particular interest.

Studio art majors may complete a minor in art history by taking three additional art history courses beyond the three required for the studio art major, for a total of six courses.
