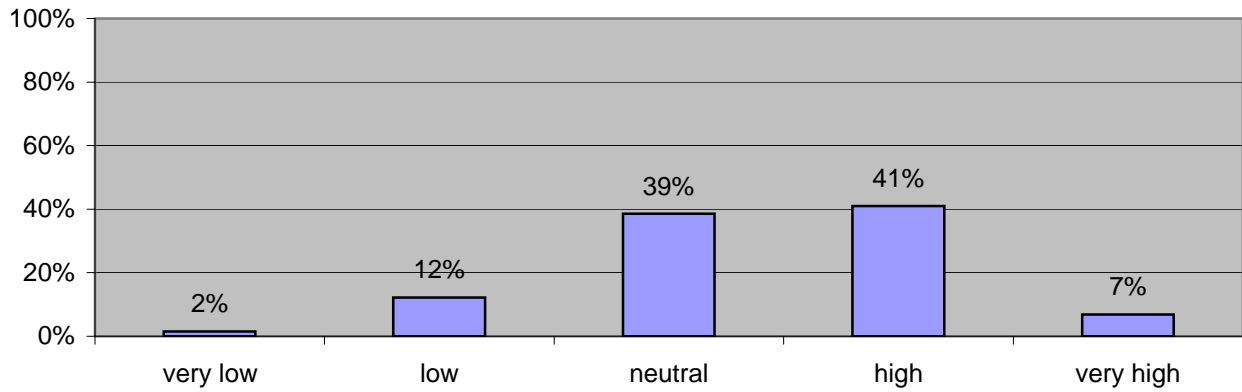

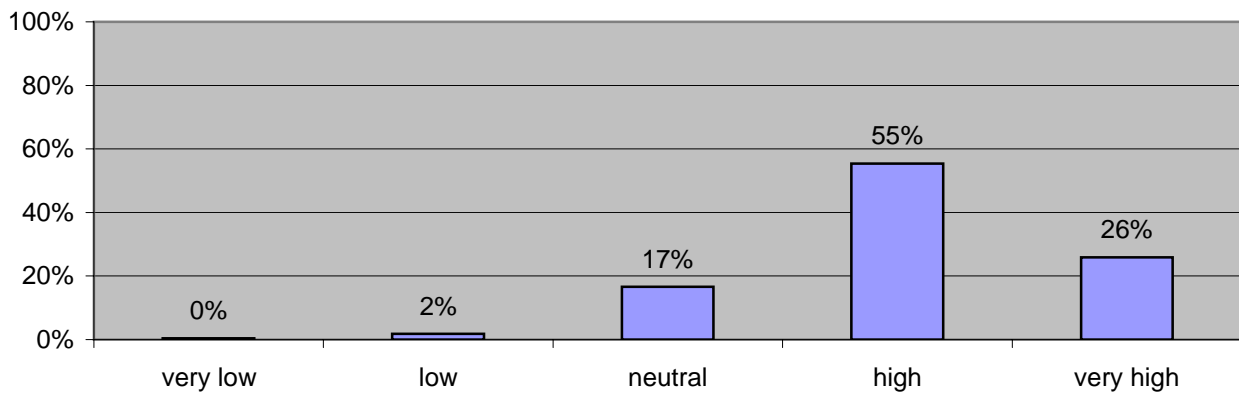

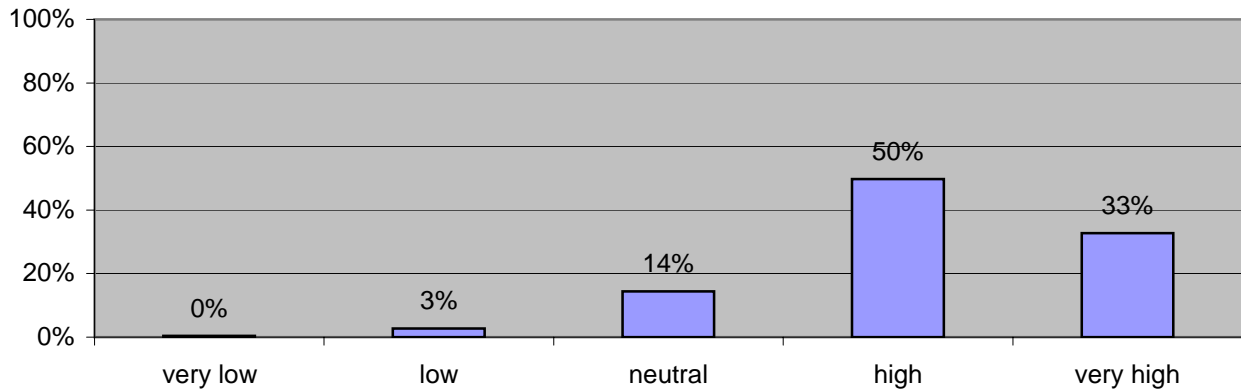
How would you rate the average student's understanding of Wheaton's Honor Code?



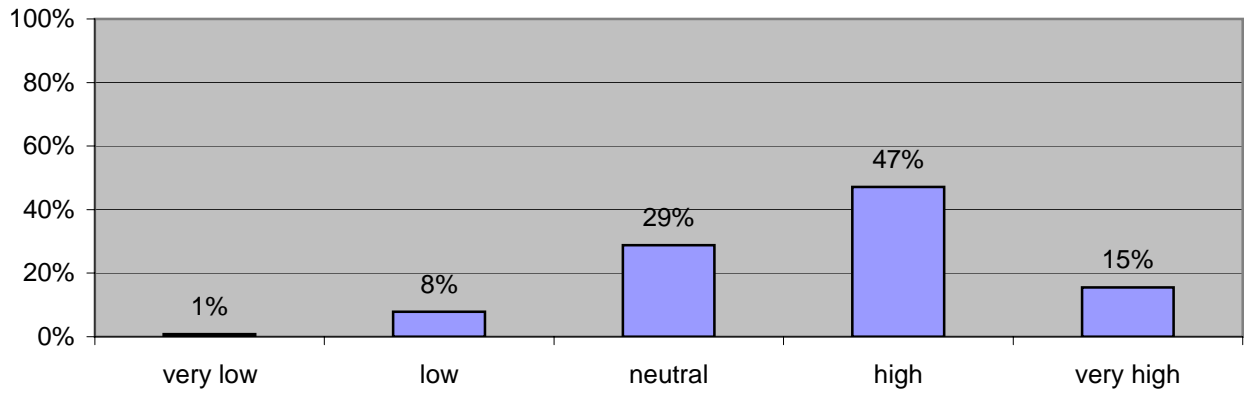
How would you rate your understanding of Wheaton's Honor Code?



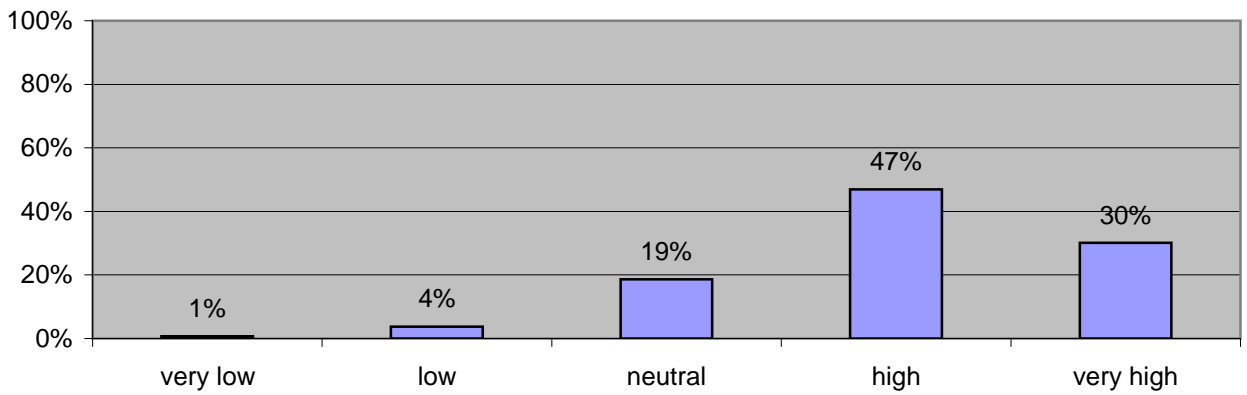
How would you rate the faculty's understanding of Wheaton's Honor Code?



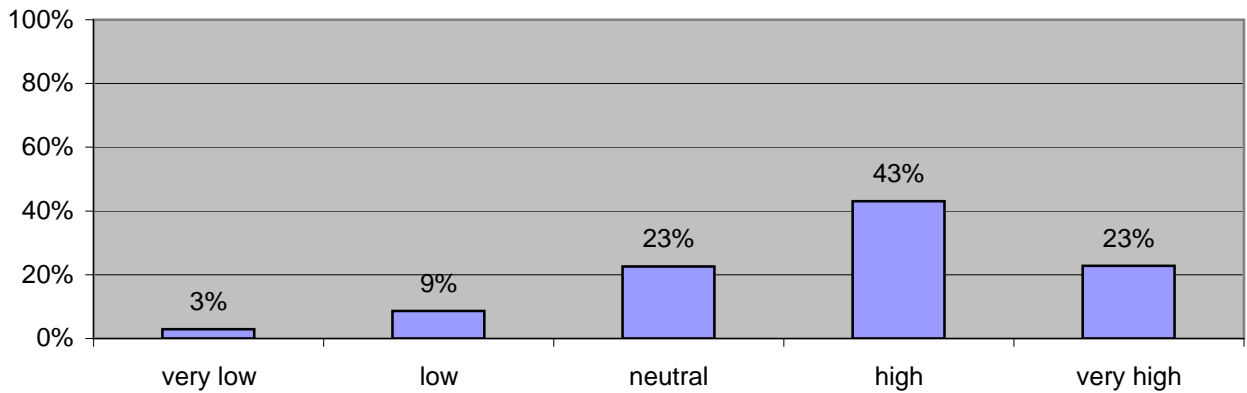
How would you rate the competitiveness for grades at Wheaton?



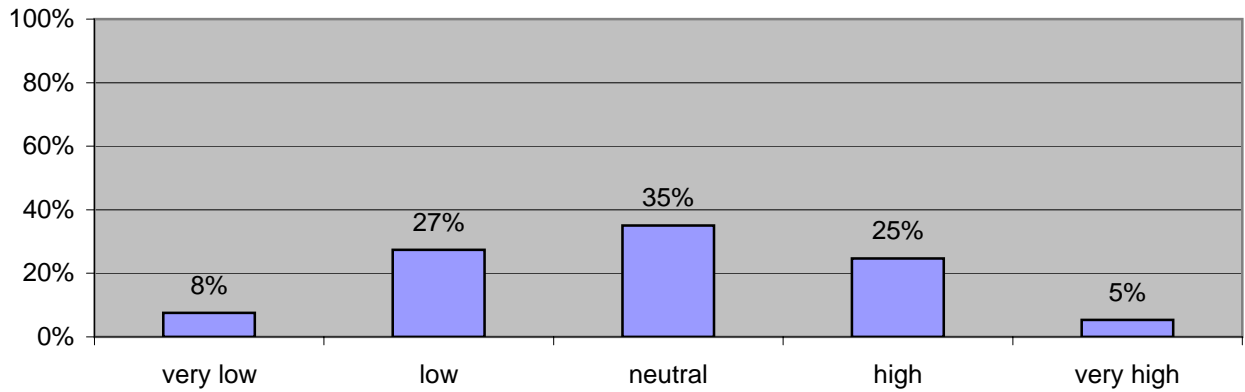
How would you rate the pressure you feel for getting good grades?



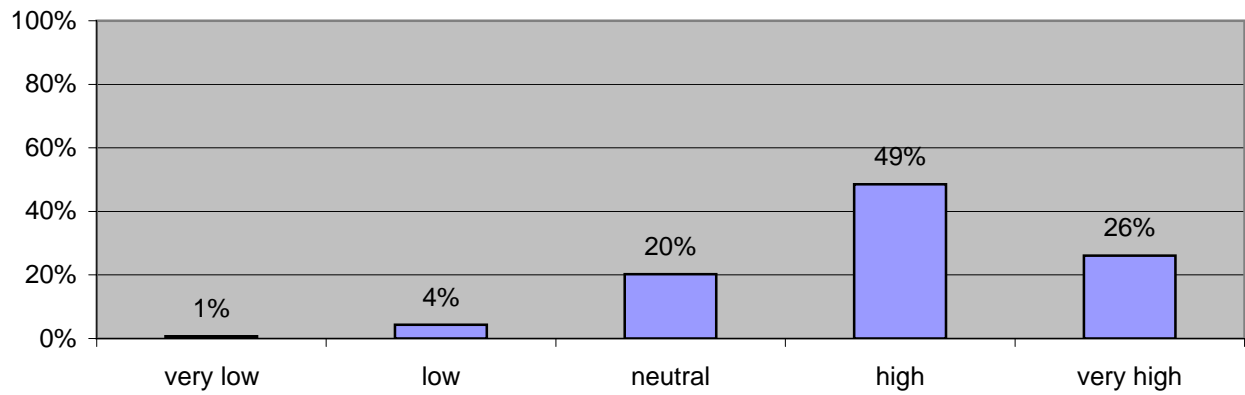
How would you rate severity of penalties for cheating at Wheaton?



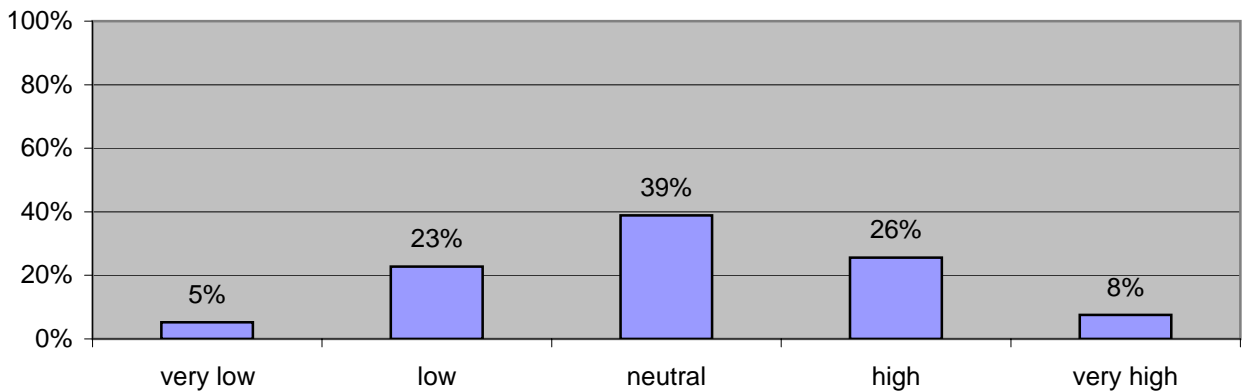

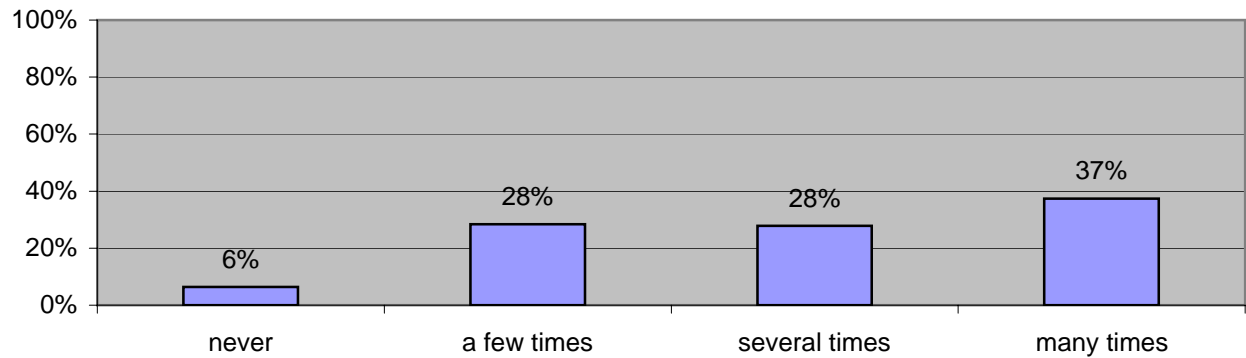
How frequently do you think the following occur at Wheaton: Plagiarism on written assignments



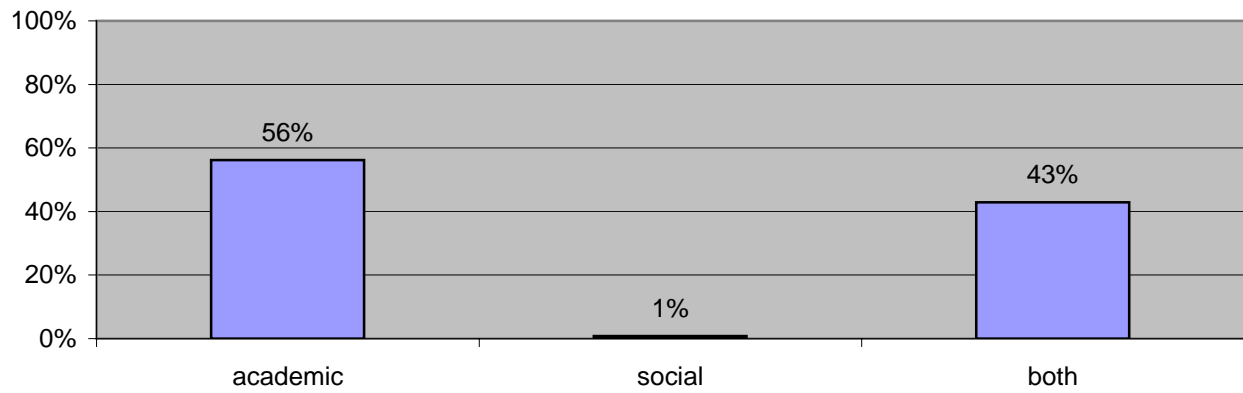
How frequently do you think the following occur at Wheaton: Cheating during tests or examinations



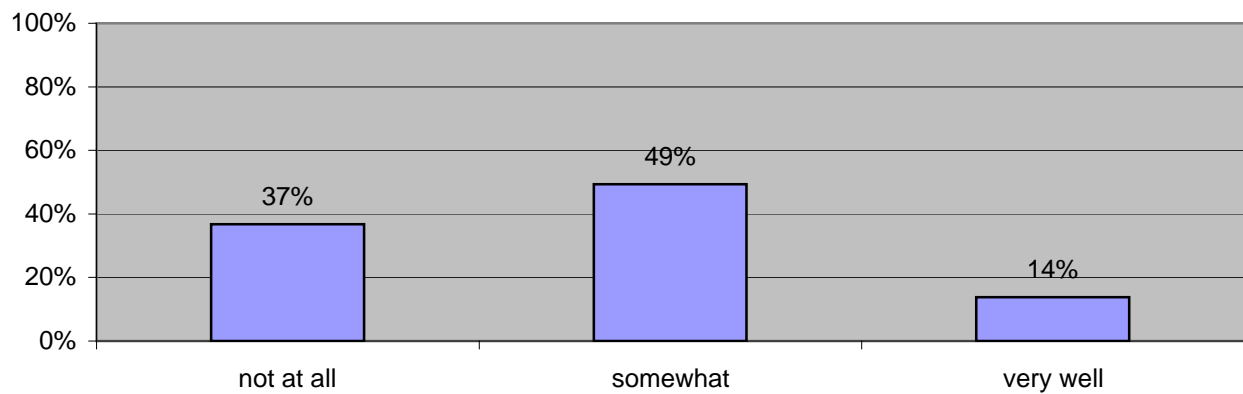
How frequently do you think the following occur at Wheaton: Vandalism on Wheaton's campus



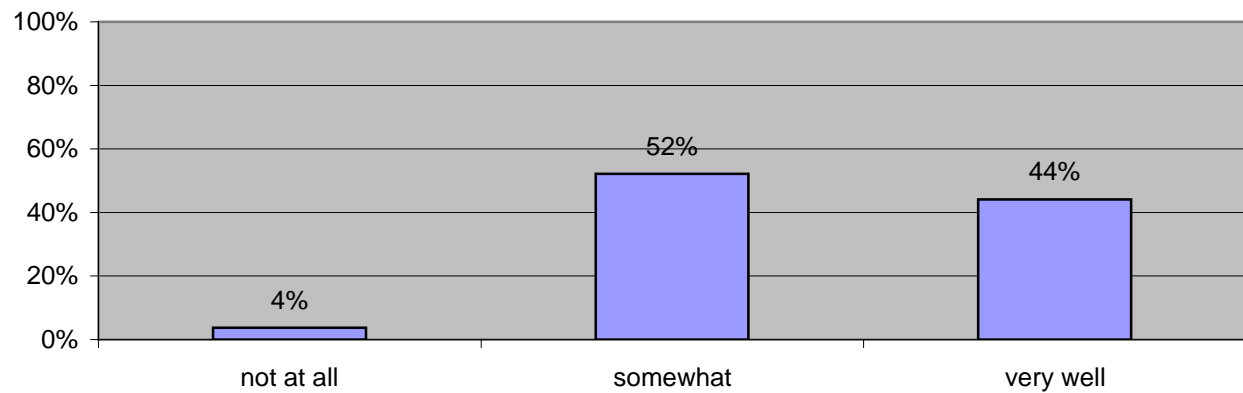

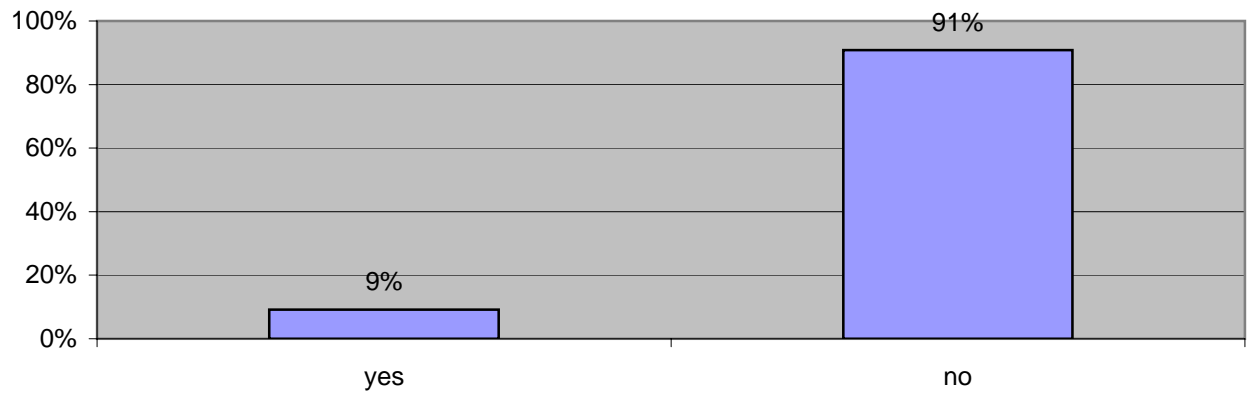
Do you think the Honor Code can be effective at Wheaton?



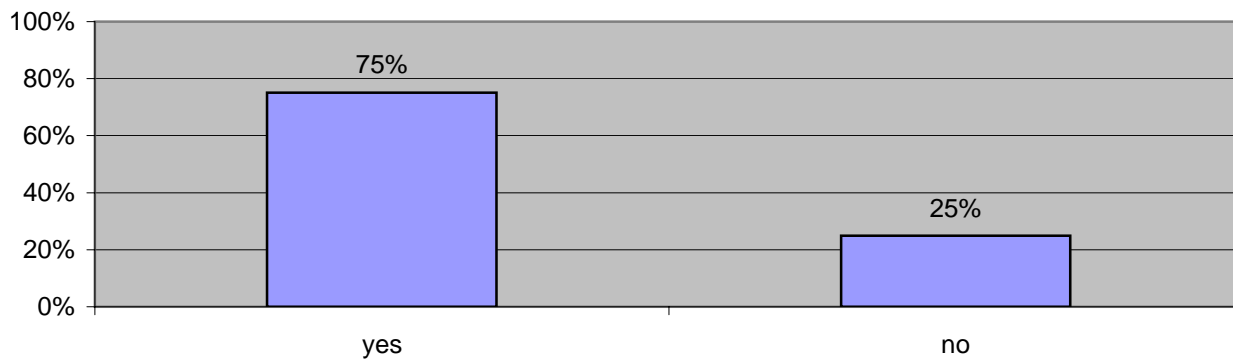

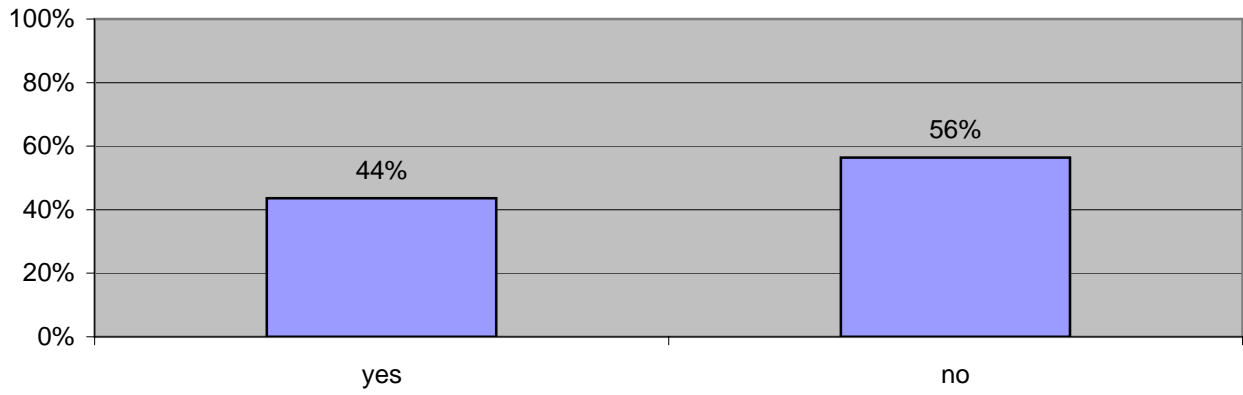

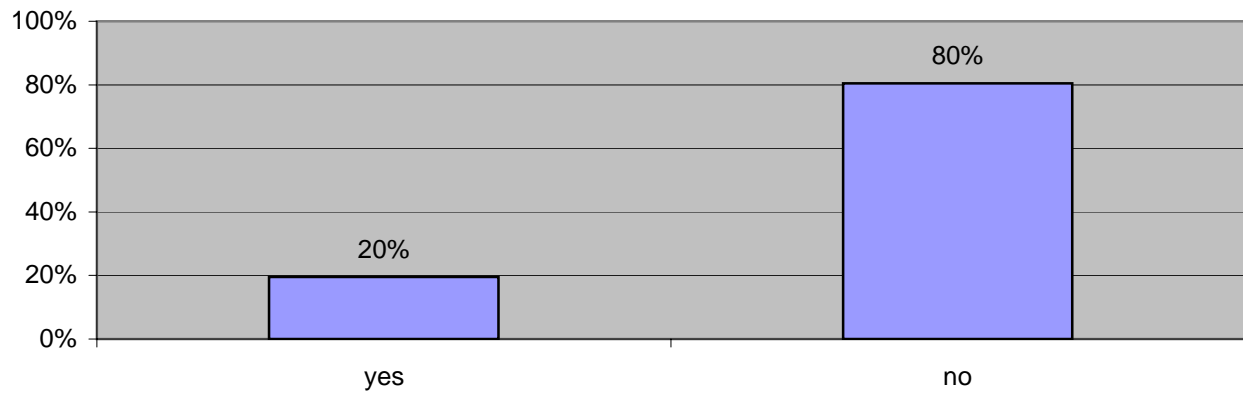
Do you consider signing someone else, who is not present, into class for attendance an Honor Code violation?



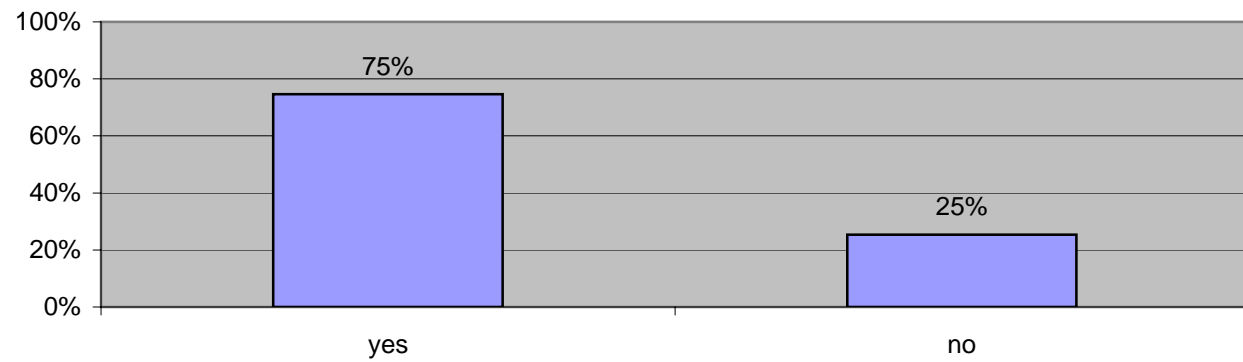

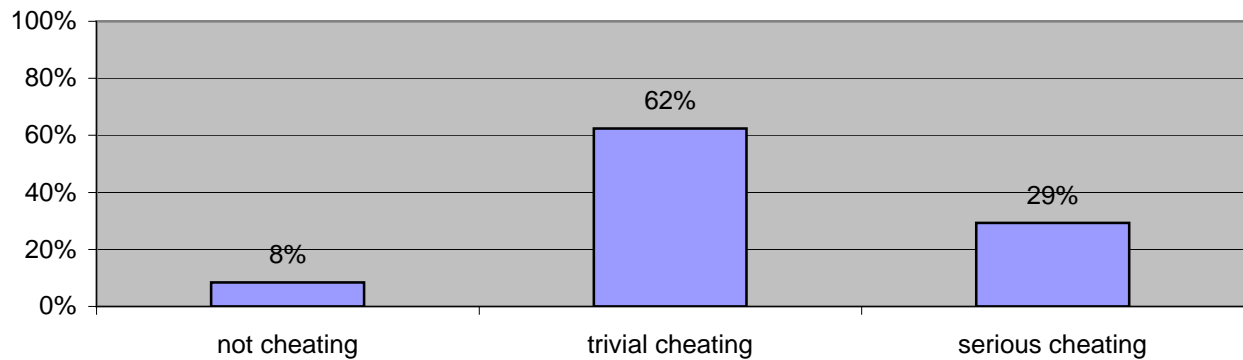
How serious are the following forms of cheating? Fabricating or falsifying a bibliography?



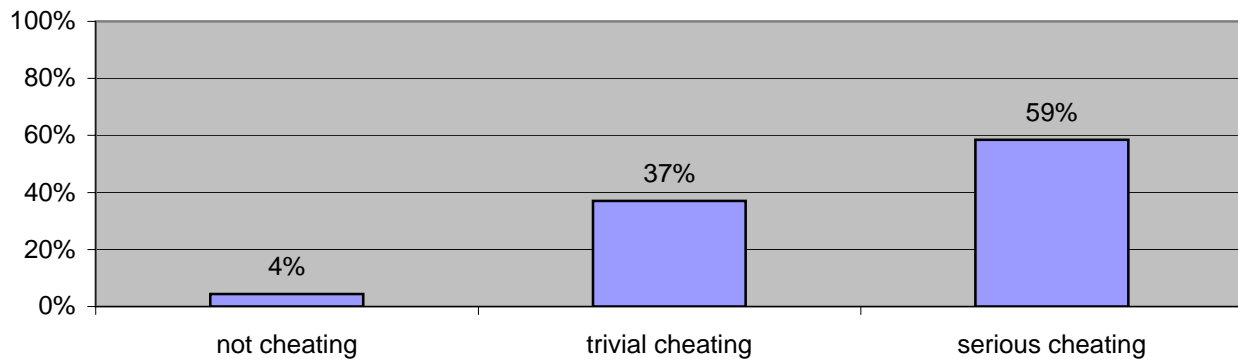
How serious are the following forms of cheating? Receiving substantial, un-permitted help on an assignment?



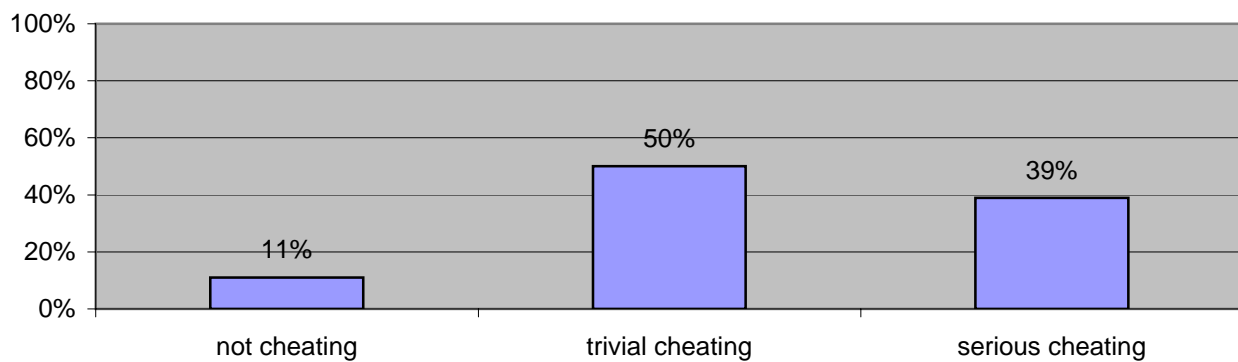
How serious are the following forms of cheating? Working on an assignment with others when the instructor asked for individual work?



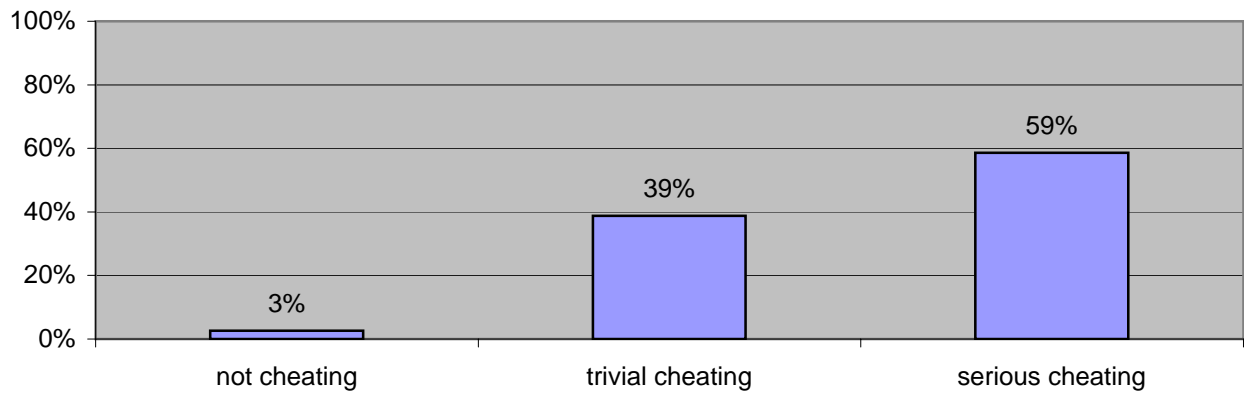
How serious are the following forms of cheating? Copying a few sentences of material without citing them in the paper?



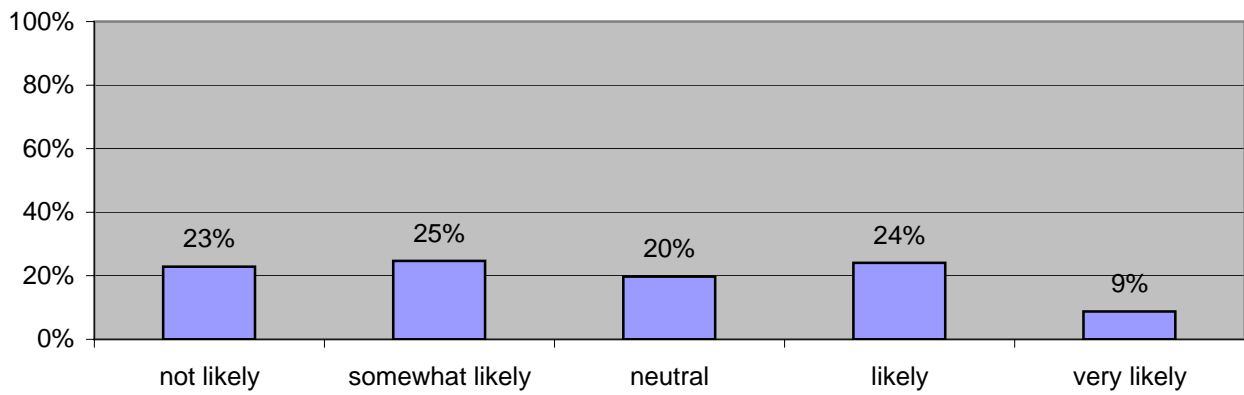

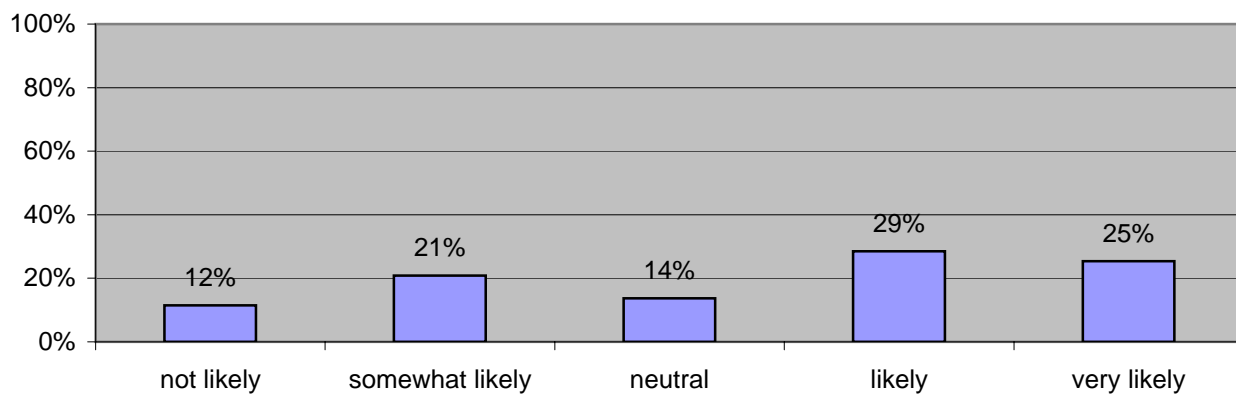
How likely is it that you would report a close friend who has violated the Honor Code?



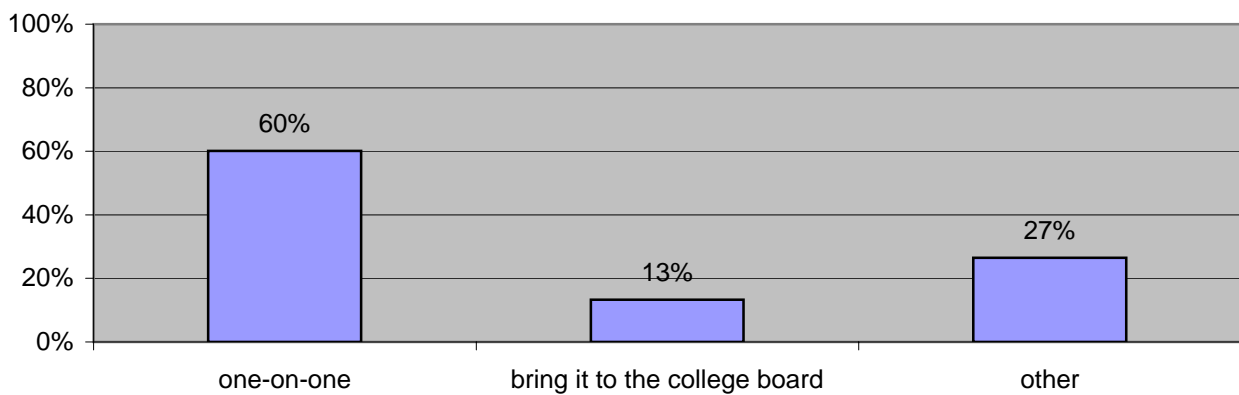

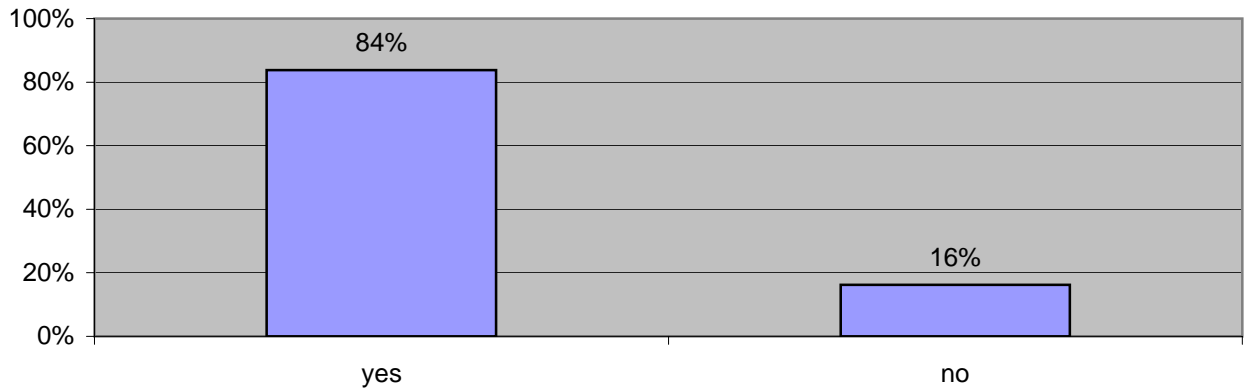

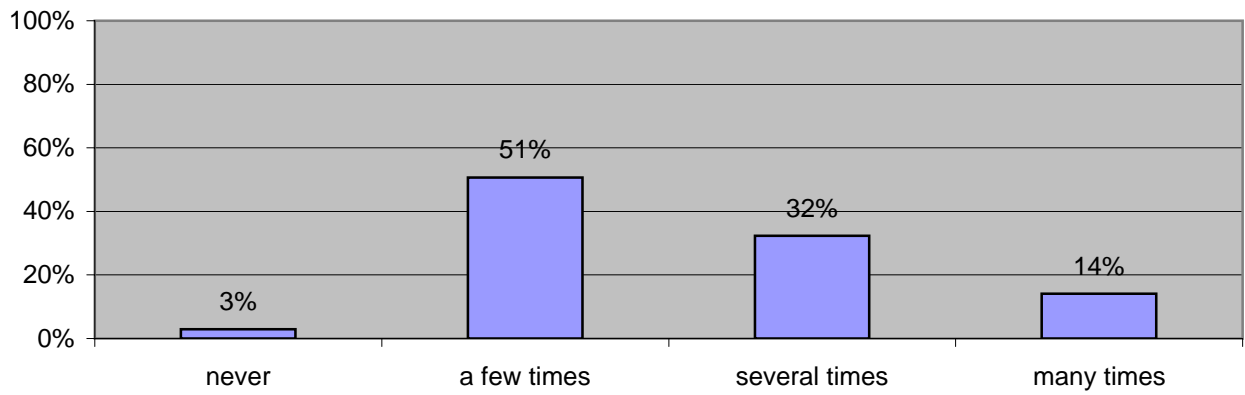
## **Bias Incidents**

A *bias incident* is generally understood to be an act directed against a person, a group or property expressing hostility or bias on the basis of gender, race, religion, national or ethnic origin, sexual orientation, disability, age or lifestyle. Bias incidents may consist of slurs, epithets, name calling, use of degrading language, graffiti, intimidation, harassment or coercion directed at the targeted person or group.
